Dealing Dividends and Divisors



You will need: deck of cards 20 index cards pen or marker





Remove all wild cards, face cards, and aces from the deck of cards. Write the following list of numbers on the index cards, 1 per card: 8, 12, 14, 15, 16, 18, 20, 21, 24, 27, 28, 30, 32, 35, 36, 40, 45, 48, 54, 63



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Shuffle the playing cards. Deal 5 to each player. Place the remaining playing cards facedown in a stack on the table. Place the index cards facedown next to the playing cards.



Turn over 1 playing card and 1 index card. Players divide the value on the index card by the value of the playing card that is turned over. If the quotient is held in one or more players' hands, those players lay down the card.



Turn over a new index card and playing card.



Have players check their own cards for the quotient. The first player to lay down all of her or his cards wins.

Example: If the index card turned over is a 54 and the playing card is a 6, then any player with a 9 in their hand can lay it down.

Note: If all of the playing cards or index cards are turned over before someone wins, reshuffle the cards and continue play.
