



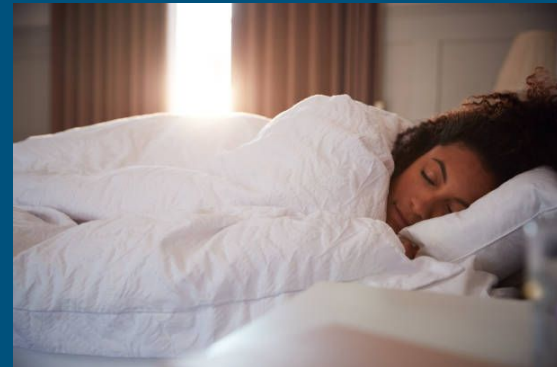

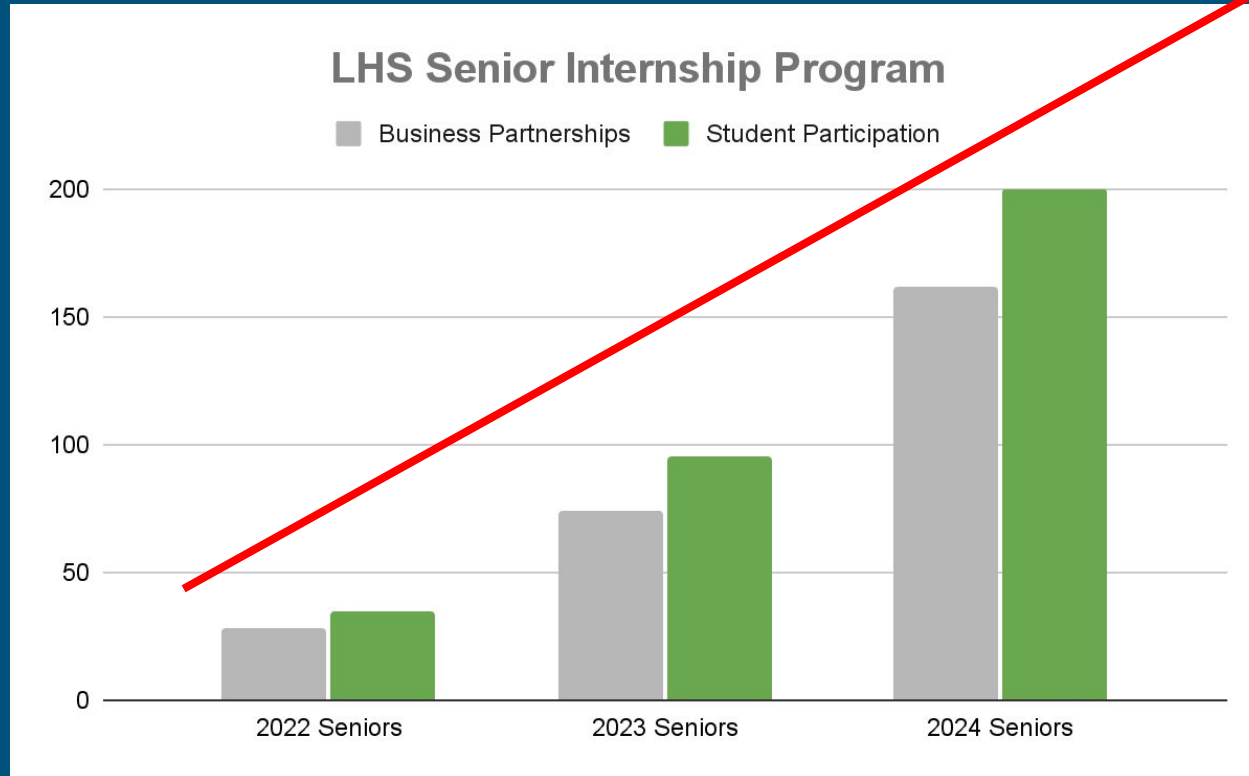

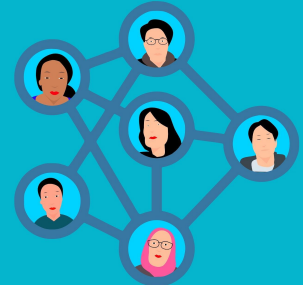

Senior Internship Program Overview

- Opportunity for students to gain real-world experience while applying course knowledge in structured environment
- Program is open to ALL seniors in good academic standing, on track to graduate in June 2025
- Students pursue an unpaid internship in an area of interest
- Internship Program Dates are May 19 - June 19, 2025 (4 weeks)



Senior Internship Program Overview

- Students are responsible for securing their internships
- Internships
 - On-site/hybrid - 25 minutes driving limit from LHS
 - Manhattan is available this year
- 20 hours per week is the requirement
- Minimum 80 hours total required
- Internship assignments & mentor reviews
- Excused from all school work.
 - *Only if you finish what your teachers require





Application, Process, Deadlines

- 2024/2025 Application will be emailed
- Application to be initiated by student
 - Application then sent electronically to Parent, Mentor, and Internship Coordinator
 - You are responsible for making sure each part of your application is completed
 - **All components of the application due February 19th, 2025**
- Completed app is reviewed
- Mr. Quack and conducts site visit to approve (in-person or virtual)
- Final internship approval
- Attend required meetings before May 19th
- What does the application look like?

Internship Requirements

- Complete required working hours (20 hours per week/80 overall)
- Complete attendance and journal assignments
 - Schedules are due the SUNDAY night before the week
- Reflections
- Mentor performance surveys
- Attending required internship meetings
 - April 9th - Lancer time or after school (location TBD)
 - May 14th after school (location TBD)
- Attending end of internship Luncheon - Tuesday June 19th (9:30 am to 11:30)
