- Scale from 650-850 with "cut" score of 750
- Assesses proficiency in:
 - Grade 10 Language Arts standards
 - Algebra I and Geometry standards
- Most recent administration March 2024 used as First Pathway in New Jersey High School Graduation Assessment Requirement
- Scale from 650-850 with "cut" score of 725 to indicate "Graduation Ready"
