Mrs. Kate Romeo will be available to students in both buildings while working very closely with our other Student Assistance Counselors, administrators, and teachers. At LHS, Mr. Amro Mohammed, introduced his new role as Dean of Students at LHS this past week to our staff. Mr. Mohammed will serve to coordinate our student assistance programming, while working as the high school's Anti-Bullying Specialist among other roles. Mr. Mohammed will work directly with students to build their skills in collaborative problem solving.

As you may already know, Mrs. Sinead Crews will be appointed as our District Director of Guidance at the September 11, 2017 Board of Education meeting. Mrs. Crews will work directly with all school counselors, school nurses, and other faculty members to ensure the social and emotional well-being of our students is at the heart of every conversation.

We are especially excited about our newest addition to the special education continuum of services ~ our transition program for students with special needs who will continue to remain at LHS until they turn 21. This program is an expansion of our already very successful Career Internship Program. It is supported by job coaches, special educators, and supportive community organizations, businesses, and individuals who work collaboratively with the District to create community based, employment opportunities for our students.
