A Maze of Numbers



You will need: A different type of coin for each player Number cube Paper and pencil



Copy the game board onto a sheet of paper. Make sure each square is big enough for at least one coin.







Place the coins at the start, outside the box.



Toss the number cube. The player with the greatest number becomes player 1. Players take turns in a clockwise fashion.



Have player 1 toss the number cube and count the number of boxes on the game board, following the arrow. If player 1 is able to correctly solve the equation in the box they landed on, they move their coin to that box. If player 1 is not able to solve the equation correctly, they stay at the current position.



Take turns tossing and solving problems. The first player to reach the end and to correctly solve the final equation wins the game.
